Enclosed is a copy of the draft Watershed Plan–Environmental Impact Statement (Plan-EIS) for the Any Creek Watershed, Any State, prepared under authority of the Watershed Protection and Flood Prevention Act (Public Law 83-566) and in accordance with section 102(2)(c) of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (Public Law 91-190). The Plan-EIS will require final approval by the appropriate committees of the Senate and House of Representatives before Federal assistance is authorized.<sup>1/</sup>
