Guidance for Enrolling Newly Acquired or Newly Eligible Land:

Scenario 1:

FSA determined that a producer had 30 eligible base acres in the 2019 signup. The participant chose to enroll 20 acres during the 2019 signup. The participant can never enroll the remaining 10 acres since they exercised their right to enroll a portion of the eligible land in FY2019.

Scenario 2:

FSA determined that a producer had 30 eligible base acres in the 2019 signup. The participant enrolled 20 acres because the remaining 10 acres were already included in an active CSP classic contract and not eligible for enrollment. The CSP classic contract is now expired and the participant may now enroll the remaining 10 acres which are “newly eligible” during the 2020 (or subsequent year) GCI signup.

Scenario 3:

FSA determined that a producer had 30 eligible base acres in the 2019 signup. The participant chose to enroll 20 acres during the 2019 signup. FSA identified an additional 40 eligible base acres (now a total of 70). The participant may enroll any or all of the 40 “newly eligible” acres in the 2020 (or subsequent year) signup, but the participant can never enroll the remaining 10 acres since they already exercised their one time right to enroll those previously eligible acres.

Scenario 4:

FSA determined that a producer had 30 eligible base acres in the 2019 signup. The producer chose not to enroll any acres during the 2019 signup. The producer may enroll any or all eligible base acres in the 2020 signup or a later signup as they have not exercised their one time right to enroll eligible land.

Scenario 5:

FSA determined that a producer had 30 eligible base acres in the 2019 signup. The participant chose not to enroll any acres during the 2019 signup. FSA has identified an additional 40 eligible base acres (now a total of 70). The participant may enroll any or all of the 70 eligible base acres in the 2020 signup or some later signup.

Scenario 6:

FSA determined that a producer had 30 eligible base acres in the 2019 signup. The participant chose to enroll all 30 acres during the 2019 signup. The participant then purchases a new farm and FSA identifies 40 eligible base acres on this new farm. The participant may enroll the additional 40 eligible base acres under a new contract in the 2020 signup or some later signup.
