This letter is to inform you that your application for the 2006 Conservation Security Program (CSP) met the program's overall objectives and was placed in an enrollment category for funding. As certified by you on the CSP Offer Certification Form you have agreed to the enrollment category assigned to the land you offered as follows:

No appeal rights have been provided you for the following reasons:

1. The enrollment category for the land you offered was established in accordance with the procedures required by the program regulation and sign-up notice published in the Federal Register on February 7, 2006.
2. Denials of assistance based on a lack of sufficient program funds are not appealable (7 CFR 614.5(d)).

If you disagree with the statements above and feel that your appeal rights have been inappropriately denied, you may request a review of appealability from the National Appeals Division (NAD). A request for an appealability review must be made no later than 30 days from the date that you received this notification. Address your request to the NAD Regional Office at the following address:
