Lesson Plan: Create a New Cost List in Conservation Desktop

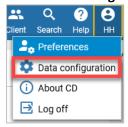
Requirements: The user is logged in to the Conservation Desktop training site and has completed the previous lesson plans.

Rationale: Cost Lists can be created in CD to be used for non-ProTracts agreements. Practice components can be created, edited or imported into the cost list.

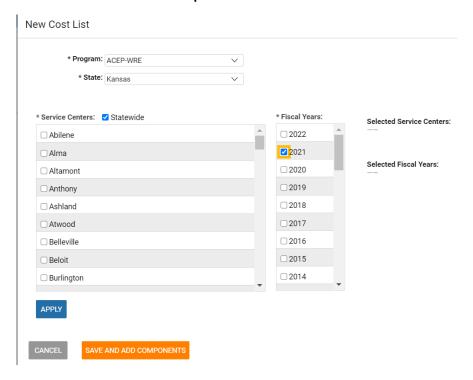
Roles that can perform lesson plan: CD-FA State Business Tools Coordinator/State Programs or CD-TA State Business Tools Coordinator/Toolkit State Role Grantor. Designated Conservationist can create a Service Center cost list.

Objectives: At the end of this lesson, you will be able to:

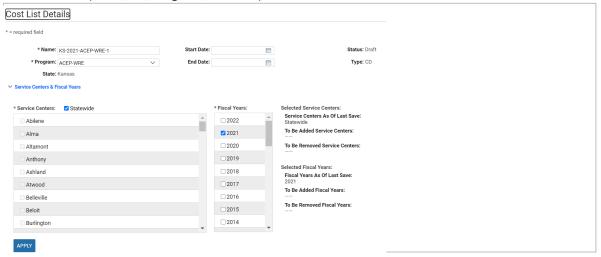
- Import a cost list
- Add practices to a cost list
- 1. Select Data Configuration located in the user's profile on the CD Toolbar.



- 2. Select Add New.
- 3. In the New Cost List menu, select the Program (ACEP-WRE), State, and Statewide, Fiscal Year(s), and select Save and Add Components.



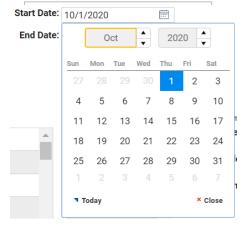
4. Verify the Cost List Details are displaying the selected State, Program, Service Centers, FY, default cost list name (State, FY, Program, Number) and status is Draft.



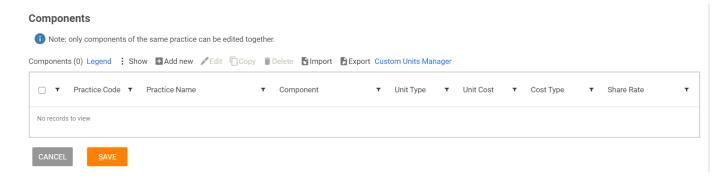
5. Change the cost list name to include state abbreviation, fiscal year, and program code.

* Name: KS-2021-ACEP-WRE

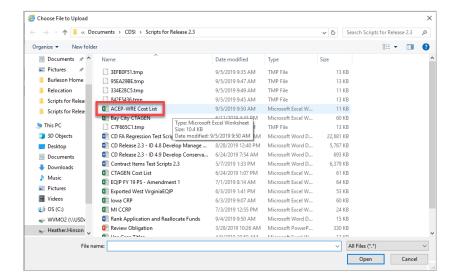
6. Set the Start Date for beginning of the fiscal year, October 1, 2020., and select APPLY



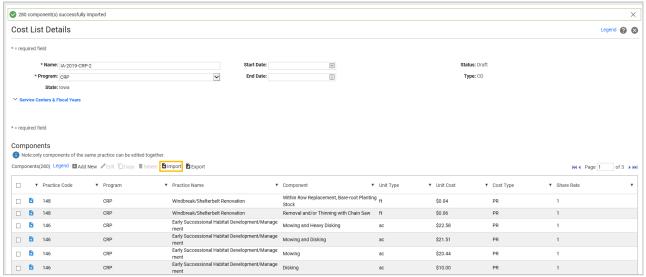
7. Select Import



8. Browse, select the ACEP-WRE Cost List created for FY 2021 and select Open.



9. Verify components are imported. The blue folder icons indicate the components have imported successfully but haven't been saved.

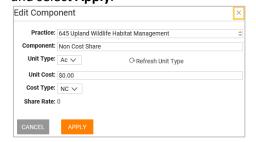


10. To add a practice to a cost list, select **Add New**.

11. Select Practice, enter in a component name, verify **unit type**, enter and select **Apply**.

12. The practice codes were added to the cost list, changes will show up at the top of the list.



- 13. Scroll down and select SAVE.
- 14. The blue folder icons will be removed.



- 15. Close the Cost List by selecting the **X** in the upper right-hand corner.
- 16. Select **X** in the upper right-hand corner to close out of Data Configuration.
