512.70 Exhibit A – OSHA 3071 Job Hazard Analysis

Procedure for contractor to do a Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) prior to construction for federal contracts. The JHA identifies work site hazards that can be minimized by design, by administration, or by Personal Protective Equipment.

512.71 Exhibit B – NRCS Job Hazard Analysis Form

States may use at their discretion prior to construction on non-federal contracts. For federal contracts, contractors may use Exhibit B -NRCS Job Hazard Analysis Form to their JHA. The JHA identifies work site hazards that can be minimized by design, by administration, or by Personal Protective Equipment.
